Physical therapy reduces hospital time and improves physical abilities for patients with cancer going through rehabilitation.

Support policies that expand access to care and coverage for physical therapist treatment of patients with cancer.

Choosing a physical therapy-based telerehab program over monthly home monitoring for cancer rehabilitation results in an average net benefit of

\$3,514

including all the hidden costs of a patient's time, pain, and missed life events; and the dollars paid for the services.

Physical therapy also helps patients:

Increase overall function.

Reduce the number of days spent in the hospital.

Reduce time spent at additional inpatient facilities.
